

Career and Technology Education (CTE) Programs Application for Food-Based Fundraiser

CTE programs may use this form only when food or drinks do not meet USDA Smart Snacks in School requirements.

Application Process

1. Check to make sure products do not meet Smart Snack standards.
2. Submit a complete application 4-6 weeks prior to the event.
3. CTE exempted fundraisers may last up to 10 school days per quarter/trimester.
4. Receive communication from USBE Child Nutrition Programs about application results.
